ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Universal prekindergarten program means a program which provides curriculum and activities, 5 days/week, 2 1/2 hours/day, which are appropriate to the age-level and individual needs of eligible children and which promote cognitive, linguistic, physical, cultural, emotional and social development. Activities shall be learner-centered and shall be designed and provided in a way that promotes the child's total growth and development in all areas including emergent English literacy. Children are encouraged to be self-assured and independent.



Eligible child means a child who resides within the school district who is four years of age on or before December 1st of the year in which he or she is enrolled or who will otherwise be first eligible to enter public school kindergarten commencing with the following school year.

Transportation is not provided and is the responsibility of the parent/guardian

Eligible children are those who reside within the school district and are four years of age on or before December 1st of the year in which he or she is enrolled or who will otherwise be first eligible to enter public school kindergarten commencing with the following school year. Selection is based on a lottery system.

Transportation is NOT provided and is the responsibility of the parent / caregiver.
