Where are you in the application process?

At this point students should have their **Common App** account set up! Students should be working on their applications.

We encourage students to have all applications completed before the holiday break in December. We will **NOT** be submitting applications during the holiday. Make note of any January 1 deadlines!

If you are applying to a school that is NOT on the Common App, you will need to let your counselor know. Make sure that it is on your list in Naviance as well.

Please Note: Your email address will become your username and the Common App's primary method of sending updates and reminders so make sure that you provide an email **that you check on a regular basis**.

Naviance Student and Senior Year

Students should ensure their Naviance list of "Colleges I am Applying To" stays accurate.

Letters of Recommendation

Students will request letters of recommendation from teachers via Naviance Student. Students should have a conversation with teachers in advance of sending the request. We encourage students to give teachers at least **two weeks** to complete a letter. Keep in mind that teachers are receiving requests from multiple students.

FAFSA/Financial Aid

The FAFSA is the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. It will open online in December. This information will be relevant to **every** student completing the FAFSA. ALL college bound students should complete a FAFSA, regardless of whether you think you might qualify for aid or not. It can seem overwhelming, take it one step at a time!

DEADLINES!

Senior year moves quickly. The fall can be an overwhelming time for students and families. We recommend keeping deadlines on a calendar that is easy to access. Make note of application deadlines **and** financial aid deadlines. Application deadlines indicate when the student must have **their** portion of the application submitted. Transcripts and supporting documentation will follow once the student SUBMITS their application. Staying organized is one of the best ways to reduce the stress of this process and ensure that everything is completed on time.

Student Responsibilities

Students are responsible for notifying their counselors of **any** changes or updates regarding their application submissions. Students oversee their individual application process. We are here to assist and ensure that transcripts are delivered in a timely fashion. If students have questions at any time they should make an appointment with their counselor.

SUNY FREE APPLICATION WEEKS!
