
Our vision is to enhance student retention and understanding through soft skills, nurturing a sense of community, selfawareness, and purpose-driven living.

Our tailored mentorship empowers students to develop vital soft skills, enhancing personal growth and lifelong learning aspirations. The I.M.I Club is central to this mission, offering workshops and sessions aimed at fostering social, emotional, and career skills. Mentors, drawn from the local student body, leverage their shared experiences to guide and inspire, serving as crucial links in the educational journey from classroom to community.

- Our holistic services extend through The I.M.I Club, providing workshops and sessions that nurture social, emotional, and professional competencies. By setting ambitious benchmarks for discipline, graduation rates, and engagement, we're crafting an environment where students are not just informed and inspired but also ready to thrive in their futures.



Over the past two years, Career InTouch Inc. has significantly developed its programs, with an eye on expansion in for the 2024-2025 academic school year. *The I.M.I Program*, a cornerstone in our efforts, operates in Bailey Middle School, Miller Middle School, and Kingston High School, and plans to broaden its reach to include more female students, particularly girls of color. This initiative aligns with our goal of diversifying education and mentorship opportunities.

Previously, the "3 Pillars of Success" program at John F. Kennedy Elementary School catered to third and fourth graders, focusing on experiential learning and personal growth. However, due to financial constraints, this program has been discontinued.

In contrast, the "EntreSkills" program, targeting ninth graders, continues to thrive through our partnership with the Small Business Development Center of New York. This program offers comprehensive entrepreneurial education, preparing students for business challenges in a global context.

These efforts showcase our commitment to creating a diverse, skilled, and empowered student body, equipped to face future challenges. Our strategic vision for 2025 includes reaching out to 25 students, predominantly girls of color, across our middle school programs, furthering our mission of inclusive and impactful education.

# What have we been able to do in a year?

- Career InTouch Inc. has made remarkable strides in enhancing and expanding its educational programs, with ambitious plans for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Our flagship I.M.I Program, currently active in several schools, is set to extend its empowering reach, focusing on increasing the involvement of female students, especially girls of color, to foster a diverse learning environment.
- While we have seen the unfortunate discontinuation of the "3 Pillars of Success" program due to budgetary limits, our "EntreSkills" program for ninth graders is flourishing, offering entrepreneurial education in partnership with the Small Business Development Center of New York. Looking ahead, we aim to impact an additional 25 students in our middle school programs, prioritizing inclusivity and educational excellence to prepare a skilled and adaptable student body for the challenges of the future.
