NO-COST BREAKFAST AND LUNCH AVAILABLE TO ALL STUDENTS!

DID YOU KNOW?

Research has shown that students who have access to nutritious meals throughout the school day have better attendance, improved concentration, and higher test scores.

Thanks to increased State funding secured by New York State Senator Michelle Hinchey and the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) designation granted by the New York State Education Department, the Kingston City School District (KCSD) can now provide nutritious breakfast and lunch at no cost to students! All KCSD students are eligible.


HERE'S WHAT IT MEANS FOR YOU:

- ✓ Your child is eligible for one wholesome breakfast and lunch every school day.
- ✓ No application is needed! Meals are available to all students, regardless of financial circumstance.
- ✓ Families can still add funds to their child(ren)'s prepaid account for optional purchases, such as an additional portion item, beverages and snacks. Funds can be added to a prepaid account by sending a check or cash with your student or by using MySchoolBucks. Cash is always accepted at the register.
