

## Kingston City School District Secondary Summer Programming

We are looking forward to an in-person summer school 2021! Summer school will be July 6-23 and July 26- August 13th for grades 5-8. Kingston High School summer programming will run July 6- August 10<sup>th</sup>. This free learning opportunity is available to incoming 5<sup>th</sup>- 12th grade students for the 2020-21 school year. We are also excited about providing free breakfast and lunch to ALL students in attendance. Check out the sections below for more details!

We are incredibly excited to have students and teachers back in our buildings! Over the last several months, our administrative team has been working on summer school and fall re-entry plans and protocols that will keep students and employees healthy while balancing the need for normalcy at school.

In order to create these plans and protocols, committees made up of individuals representing various viewpoints and employee groups collaborated to develop recommendations. The Kingston CSD has continued to work closely with the Ulster County Department of Health. Every effort has been, and will continue to be, made to create healthy environments for our students. Below you will find the list of protocols we will implement for summer school.

<b>Summer School Protocols July- August 2021</b>	
<b>Take Note</b> The protocols detailed below have been created in conjunction with the KCSD Covid-19 Director and the Ulster County Dept. of Health. They are subject to change based on further recommendations.	
<b>Arrival and Dismissal</b> Students and faculty/staff will be screened Students will use hand sanitizer upon entering class Students will be socially distanced for dismissal	<b>Classrooms and Facilities</b> Class sizes will be no greater than 20 Shared school supplies or equipment discouraged or will be sanitized
<b>Breakfast and Lunch</b> Breakfast will be eaten in classrooms Lunches will be "grab and go." Hand washing and hand sanitizer will be available	<b>Health and Hygiene</b> Masks must be worn except while eating or during mask breaks Social distancing practices will be maintained
<b>Visitors and Volunteers</b> Non-essential visitors will not be permitted No volunteers will be allowed except those already approved for participation in the program	<b>Cleaning and Sanitizing</b> Spaces will be cleaned and sanitized daily Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the buildings

## Middle School Summer School- Held at JWB

In-person summer school for all incoming 5-8 students for both M. Clifford Miller Middle School and J. Watson Bailey Middle School will take place July 6-July 23<sup>rd</sup> and then again July 26<sup>th</sup>-August 13<sup>th</sup>, Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Transportation is provided and the doors open at 7:50 a.m. Students cannot be dropped off before 7:45 a.m. and need to be picked up by 1:00 p.m. Breakfast & lunch are provided for FREE! As a reminder, incoming 5th-8th graders for the 2021-22 school year will be at JWB for summer school.

Academically, there will be a focus on Reading and math skills. There will also be social-emotional programming offered inclusive of the Peaceful Guardians program, Family of Woodstock and others.

Breakfast and lunch will be provided.

### **DROP OFF**

Doors will open at 7:50 a.m. at JWB. All middle school students will be dropped off in the front of the building.

### **PICK-UP**

All students will be picked up in the front of the building. Please do not ask your student to meet you in the parking lot, as that places students weaving in and out of traffic.

## High School Summer School- Held at KHS

Summer School will be held from Monday, July 6th through Tuesday, August 10th from 8:15 AM- 1:30 PM. School will be in session Monday- Thursday. Transportation will be provided and the doors open at 8:05. All students will enter using the Salzmann entrance. A free lunch and breakfast will be provided daily to all students attending summer school at KHS. Students may also bring their own food and drink. As a reminder, incoming 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders for the 2012-22 school year will be at KHS for summer school.

Academically, courses in all core areas as well as health, physical education, keyboarding, and language. These courses will be offered in-person as well as by utilizing our credit recovery program (as we have for many years). Additionally, there will be team-building and social-emotional programming for all 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders and available to 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders.
