- > Support District Educational Goals & Student Achievement
- ➤ Align Budget with the Goals of the BOE & Superintendent
- ► Maintain Programs & Offerings Funded by CRRSA Act
- Maintain Smaller Elementary Class Sizes Districtwide
- ► Increase the Number of Buses Available to Transport Students
- Keep Tax Revenues at or below the Tax Levy Limit (Tax Cap)
- Maximize the Additional Foundation Aid allocated for 2023-2024
- Long Range Fiscal Stability







SEVEN YEAR BUDGET HISTORY: BUDGET - TAX LEVY - OTHER REVENUES




SEVEN YEAR BUDGET HISTORY: BUDGET - TAX LEVY - OTHER REVENUES
