  - Playgrounds: Additional testing being conducted this week, covering lead levels and other substances. Results will be reported to the community.
  - Calendar reminders: 10/26 parent/teacher conferences (PreK--4), 10/27 early dismissal (PreK--k-4), 11/2 County-wide emergency evacuation drill, early dismissal for all students (15 mins early), 11/7 election day, no school for students.
  - Dietz Stadium: Construction is proceeding, focus on the stands, track, concessions, lighting.

- PreK: KCSD has been awarded additional PreK funding. This is in addition to the increase received over the summer, which enabled the district to cover PreK for all 4-year-olds (funding is only available to 4-year-olds). The most recent funding will be used to increase the per-student allotment given to local PreK providers.
- Transportation: Meeting with bus companies to find solutions to driver/route challenges. Safety review of Camden/buses used for athletics and band was conducted. The company is out-of-state, but is certified in NYS and meets state and federal requirements (satisfactory rating, which is the highest). They have a good safety record.
- Greeters/monitors in elementary schools: Greeters/monitors will be in all elementary schools by next week. Raptor technology will be used to scan IDs of visitors to track visitors and to flag potential issues. Several different kinds of ID can be used.
- Technology: KCSD is a one-to-one district. Students in Grades K-4 have access to their Chromebook in the classroom; Grades 5-12 can take theirs home.
- Proposition 1: Proposition 1, which will appear on the ballot in November, would equalize NYS school districts' ability to finance school construction. Currently, small city school districts (of which KCSD is one) are at a disadvantage. For more information: https://www.kingstoncityschools.org/nyprop1
