**RESOLUTION #2018-BOE18**  
**2018-2019 Superintendent Goals**

1. The Superintendent will monitor and support the goals set in the District Comprehensive Improvement Plan and submit quarterly reports to the Board of Education of the progress toward these goals (dates provided on the Annotated Board Calendar).
2. The superintendent will provide the Board of Education with quarterly reports on short and long-term suspensions, disaggregated by student sub group. The Superintendent will also provide the Board with a summary of Restorative Justice professional development, practices and data related to the use of these practices.
3. By August 29, 2018, the Superintendent will present the Board with a report on Faculty and staff Diversity.
4. By November 14, 2018, the Superintendent will present the Board of Education with a report on Anti-Bullying efforts in the Kingston City School District (past, present and future).
5. By November 28, 2018, the Superintendent will present the Board with information regarding all Grant Funded Programs currently operating in the Kingston City School District.
6. By September 12<sup>th</sup>, the Superintendent, in conjunction with the Teaching and Learning Department will provide the Board of Education with a report on the, newly implemented Mental Health Curriculum for the Kingston City School District.
7. By April 1, 2019, The Superintendent will provide the Board of Education with an overview of the APPR process and the District aggregate progress status. This report will include any teacher or administrator improvement plans and number of teachers eligible and being recommended for tenure.
8. By April 24, 2019, the Superintendent, in collaboration with the Teaching and Learning Committee will provide the Board with the Annual Summary Report and BEDS data.
9. The Superintendent, will coordinate and oversee the construction of the Meagher Building Project and complete the plan for implementation of the District Funded Pre-k program, opening in September of 2019.
