










Enrollment History of English Language Learners




Building Enrollment -5 Year Trend 2017-2018




2017-18 Racial/Ethnic Distribution by School









2017-18 Free and Reduced Lunch Enrollment Sorted from Low to High Total Enrollment

2017-18 Percentage of All Students who missed 10% or More of Enrolled School Days (Chronically Absent)













ELA % Proficiency (Levels 3-4) by Grade 2017-2018




Math % Proficiency (Levels 3-4) by Grade




Common Core Algebra 1 Percentage of 8th Grade Students Scoring at Each Performance Level




2017-18 Grade 3-8 NYS Math and ELA Percent of Students Scoring at Each Performance Level






Science 4-Year % Proficiency (Levels 3 & 4) by Grade




Science Grades 4 & 8 Proficiency by Accountability Subgroups




Grades 4 & 8 NYS Science 2018 Percent of students scoring at each Performance Level





3 Year Trend for Percentage at Each Scoring Level on the NYSESLAT






Common Core Regents Examination Results 2017-18 Percent of Students Scoring at Each Performance Level




3 Year Trend Regents Exam Passing Rate (Scoring 65 or higher)









