Waiver Respite

We are seeking caring individuals for rewarding part-time, one-to-one positions, providing respite services for children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

The Waiver Respite Staff will provide 1:1 temporary care/supervision of person with special needs. Providing parent/caregiver a break from everyday routines w/ the person. Staff will provide a safe environment and may include social and community activities.

The staff who work for Waiver Respite should be flexible and self-motivated. Time management skills are definitely important in this position which requires a great deal of independence.

After-school, early evening and weekend hours are available for Waiver Respite.

Early Intervention

We are seeking caring individuals for rewarding part-time, one-to-one positions, providing Early Intervention Respite services for infants up to 3 year olds with intellectual/developmental disabilities or developmental delays.

To provide 1:1 temporary care/supervision of infant to 3 year olds with special needs. Providing parent/caregiver a break from everyday routines w/ the person. Staff will provide a safe environment and may include social and community activities.

The staff who work for Early Intervention Respite should be flexible and self-motivated. Time management skills are definitely important in this position which requires a great deal of independence.

Day hours, after-school, early evening and weekend hours are available for Early Intervention.
