This initiative will create a program to document the living history of Ulster County's senior community. Ulster County's youth volunteers will work with UlsterCorps and Office for the Aging to conduct video interviews of seniors to document their stories and create a digital repository for all County residents to enjoy.*

This initiative will recruit and place the fellows (from SUNY Ulster, SUNY New Paltz, Bard, Marist and Ulster County high schools), will pay \$13 per hour, 35 hours per week, for 5 weeks. The students will work under the guidance of their local green business/ non-profit on projects to both increase the capacity of the group and build concrete work experience for the student to prepare them for a job in the environmental and green business field.*
