To be considered for the junior privilege card which allows you to leave campus during your designated lunch period, you **must** meet the following criteria each quarter:

- Have a lunch period in current quarter schedule**
- Maintain a 65 or better in each of your classes (no incompletes)**
- Have no more than 5 unexcused tardies and/or absences to school, per quarter**
- Have no class cuts**
- Have no disciplinary referrals resulting in ISS/OSS**
- Have the signed consent of a Parent/Guardian**
- Have received no more than 5 temporary I.D cards, per quarter**

By signing this application, the student agrees to comply with the terms listed above and understands that a failure to meet these conditions and/or an abuse of this privilege will result in the revocation of the card for the remainder of the quarter. You will be issued a privilege card that must be presented when you leave school for lunch. The loss of the card will result in the loss of the privilege until the next quarterly review of records. Students must surrender the prior quarter privilege card. You must sign in/out at either the Main or Salzman entrances. You must also leave the building for the entire period. Any food brought back to campus should be put away as it cannot be eaten in classrooms. Food cannot be bought for others or sold. Please remember to properly dispose of your trash. **Card can only be used by the student to whom it was issued.** Failure to comply will result in revocation of card.
