## KINGSTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT UNIVERSAL PRE-K PROGRAM

## ATTENDANCE POLICY

It is the intent of the New York State Department of Education that Universal Pre-K slots that are funded by the New York State Program be allocated to students who will participate in the program on a FULL-TIME basis, 5 days per week, 2 ½ hours per day. As such, a student's attendance in the program is of critical importance. Recognizing this, it is incumbent upon each contracting agency to:

- 1. Maintain accurate attendance records for each child.
- 2. If the agency has any child who is absent from the program for three (3) or more consecutive days, without appropriate parental/guardian notification, the agency must <a href="IMMEDIATELY">IMMEDIATELY</a> contact the child's parent/guardian <a href="AND">AND</a> the Pre-K Program's Family Worker.
- 3. Agency funding is based on student attendance AND may need to be adjusted in a given billing period (month) to reflect appropriate attendance.
